What is the overall deductible?	In- <u>Network</u> : Individual \$2,000 / Family \$4,000.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. Emergency care; plus in- <u>network</u> office visits, <u>prescription drugs</u> & <u>preventive care</u> are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> .	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes.

If you are eligible for certain types of Minimum Essential Coverage, you may not be eligible for the premium tax credit.
